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Biography

Anne Haug

Actress

Anne Haug studied acting at the University of the Arts in Berlin. Already during her studies, she was performing in ambitious productions at the Deutsches Theater and the Maxim Gorki Theater in Berlin and working with directors such as René Pollesch and Viktor Bodó. She attracted international attention in Isabell Šuba's film debut 'Männer zeigen Filme & Frauen ihre Brüste' ('Men Show Films and Women Show Their Breasts'), which won the Award of the Youth Jury from the Max Ophüls Film Festival as well as the prize for best socially relevant film.

Her convincing portrayal of a young director who must deal with her incompetent producers and the stone-age, stereotyped behavior in the film industry was widely acclaimed. For her outstanding acting ability, she won the renowned 'Drama Scholarship' of the Migros Cultural Percentage and the Ernst Göhner Foundation two years in a row. She recognized the artistic possibilities of an actress very early on, and began to write and direct plays. In addition, she has been writing plays as well as film and television formats since 2011 and her very successful theater series 'Project Schoorli' since 2013, which was invited to the Theatertreffen or the feature film 'Take Me Too' in which she also plays the lead role. In 2022 Anne Haug was awarded the prestigious Schiller Memorial Prize for the Advancement of Drama for her work as a writer.

From the beginning of her career, her distinct and powerful way of acting which effortlessly changes between drama and comedy, aroused the attention of directors who significantly influence film and theater of today. Anne Haug is always seeking creative collaborations with authors and directors who address the current changes in society, such as Aelrun Goette, Anna Bergmann, Antú Romero Nunes, Barbara Kulcsar, Emily Charriot, Fabian Stumm, Isabell Šuba, Laura Lackmann, Lena May Graf, Lola Arias, Maris Pfeiffer, Max Färberböck, Natascha Beller, Nora Abdel-Maksoud, Sarah Bläßkiewitz, and Zino Wey. She has garnered praise and esteem from the press, which has pronounced her one of the outstanding actresses of her generation. Der Tagesspiegel describes her as 'furious', the Junge Bühne as 'virtuosic'.

Anne Haug works as an actress, author and director in the German-speaking world and lives in Basel and Leipzig.
