Dorka Gryllus

Actress

Dorka Gryllus studied acting at the Színház és Filmművészeti Egyetem University for Theater and Film in Budapest. Already during her first year of studies, she assumed the leading role in the film adaptation of Péter Esterházy's bestseller 'Seventeen Swans' which made her nationally famous. Immediately after completing her studies, she joined the ensemble of the renowned Csiky Gergely Theater in Kaposvár under the artistic direction of Tamás Ascher. She attracted international attention with her leading roles in Sam Garbaski's 'Irina Palm', in Fatih Akin's 'Soul Kitchen' and the Berlinale entry 'Dallas Among Us'.

For her outstanding, truthful portrayal of the young Sinti woman who tries to keep her family together and live a dignified human life under difficult circumstances, she received many awards, including the Silver Dolphin from the Festróia Festival Internacional de Cinema de Tróia, the 'Best Actress Award' of the Faces of Love International Film Festival in Socci, and the 'Shooting Star' of the Berlinale. Alongside engagements in many important European and American theaters and institutions, including the Deutsches Theater and HAU in Berlin, the Kunsthistorisches Museum and Volkstheater in Vienna, PS122 in New York, the Atrium, Örkény, as well as the Thalia Theater in Budapest, the actress has appeared in many ambitious national and international film and television productions such as 'Baptiste' (United Kingdom), 'Collapse' (Germany), 'Demimonde' (Hungary), 'Fateful Years' (Germany), 'Irina Palm' (United Kingdom), 'Soul Kitchen' (Germany), 'The Bone Man' (Austria), 'The Investigation' (Germany) and 'Weekend' (Hungary).

Her natural portrayals of human motivations have made Dorka Gryllus a much sought-after European actress. Leading cultural publications and the trade press recognize her as an actress who can convincingly bring the most complex motives of her characters to life. The movie trade magazine 'Vox' writes: 'Even with very little dramatic means, she can convincingly portray a character's suppressed storms of emotion.' Dorka Gryllus' characters testify to a sensitive and precise acting that reveals the entire range of emotions in her quiet face with expressive force. Alongside her acting career, Dorka Gryllus performs regularly as lead singer for different bands, including 'Ef Zámbo Happy Dead Band' and 'Rotfront'. Dorka Gryllus now also works as a director for the theater. She celebrates successes with her productions of 'Me, Iphigenia' and 'SZX_MCHN', which were invited to both the renowned Budapest Spring Festival and the international Sziget Festival in Budapest.

Dorka Gryllus works internationally as an actress and lives in Berlin and Budapest.
